Gosselin Group N.V. of Antwerp, Belgium is very pleased to confirm that the litigation which has been pending since 2002 against Gosselin and Marc Smet as Managing Director has ended very favorably in judgments entered by the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Virginia on February 14, 2012. The United States and Relators had pursued a civil action for extensive damages and civil penalties against Gosselin and Mr. Smet personally on allegations brought under the US False Claims Act and other provisions.

Following a jury verdict and the Memorandum Opinion and resulting judgments issued by the Court yesterday, the United States and Relators were awarded a total of \$5,500 as a single civil penalty in connection with the ITGBL/household-related allegations for the IS02 cycle. Allegations relating to other ITGBL cycles were dismissed or resulted in verdicts affirmatively in favor of Gosselin and Mr. Smet. Neither Gosselin nor Mr. Smet were ordered to pay damages to the United States or to Relators on any of their allegations in this action. In addition, the Court held that Gosselin and Mr. Smet were not obligated to pay any civil penalties in connection with a separate contract claim.

Gosselin has been advised by its counsel that an appeal by the United States and Relators from the judgments entered yesterday remains a possibility. However, Gosselin will oppose any appeal action undertaken with the same vigor as it has opposed from the outset the unfounded allegations pursued by the United States and Relators. Gosselin is confident that these judgments, should they be appealed by the United States or Relators, will be affirmed.

Gosselin wishes to take this opportunity to thank its loyal and valued customers for standing by Gosselin throughout this extended and difficult litigation, and to assure each of our customers that Gosselin will continue to render services in all of its operations with the highest level of integrity, efficiency and quality for which our Company has a well-earned reputation.
